

Hello Parents and Students.

We hope that you are all safe and well. We have updates below about the end of the school year, the budget outlook, and the start of planning for reopening in August.

End of School Year

- The last day for lunch delivery will be June 1st.
- We will have students' belongings set out at the curb for you to pick up from 8-12, June 1st-3rd.
- If you have any school books, library books, or other school property at home, please return it when you pick up your belongings.
- If you checked a silver Samsung Chromebook out from the school, please keep in mind that these are for the students to keep.
- We have been informed by public health that we cannot have any direct contact with students and families for graduation. We will have a video presentation for the graduation. The links will be sent out the last week of school.

Budget

- We are expecting an overall cut of about 7.5% (approximately \$500,000) to our budget for the coming school year.
- We have put in every effort to maintain classes and services and minimize any purchases to those absolutely necessary for the school.
- There is a great deal of uncertainty for future budget years. We will fully involve our stakeholders in discussions around possible reductions in services.
- We will focus our decisions on outcomes that best support students.

Return to School

- We are planning to have a summer school. At this time, the summer session will be virtual. If we can change that to an in person session, we will.
- We are planning for several different scenarios for the 2020-2021 school year. We do not want to send out several drafts and revisions of our plans for next school year. We will release a plan for the 2020-2021 school year no later than July 20, but probably earlier.
